

**BOROUGH OF WILMERDING  
NOTES FROM THE APRIL 5, 2016 WORKSHOP**

**ENGINEER-D. GILLILAND:** last month you awarded the Ice Plant Hill project subject to the approval of the agreement from the county.

**MR. G. EVASHAVIK:** I have reviewed the agreement and it is ready to be signed.

**MR. D. GILLILAND:** when that gets signed then we will be ready to award the contract.

**MS. S. SMITH:** the Y asked me about a start date. They have their summer camp the week of June 6<sup>th</sup> and our festival is from June 8<sup>th</sup> to the 11<sup>th</sup>. They were wondering if you could hold off on that until the week of the 13<sup>th</sup>. It would help them out and also it would help for our festival.

**MR. D. GILLILAND:** they probably won't start the project until after that.

The demolition of 104 State Street has been completed.

The door for the public works office is being fabricated and it will be installed once it is fabricated.

**MR. S. SHURGOT:** we are going to be getting this grant to pave the streets. Did we get any bids on this project or wasn't it advertised yet. It is already April and the contractors are lining up their work.

**MR. G. EVASHAVIK:** the application is almost done. I don't know how long it will be before we get the money.

**MR. D. GILLILAND:** normally it takes about a year to get the grant.

**UTILITIES – S. SMITH:** I received a letter in the mail about the cost of electricity per kilowatt hour. How long is our contract for?

**MS. K. PETERSON:** I believe it is for one year. I will look into this to see when it is up.

**FINANCE – J. THOMAS:** the tax bills are out.

**PLANNING – REV. D. REEVES:** some of the members are attending a three hour class on planning. They suggested that we should let the public know what is going on with our committee. They also said that they are willing to come and talk to us.

**SOLICITOR – G. EVASHAVIK:** we have been working on the funding agreement for Ice Plant Hill. We have been going back and forth with the county and everything is done and is satisfactory to the borough.

We drafted an ordinance for further implementation of the 2006 International Fire Code and providing for the authority of a Fire Marshall and Fire Code Official, providing for mandatory fire code inspections of commercial properties and providing for fees and penalties.
