

**BOROUGH OF WILMERDING
NOTES FROM THE JULY 3, 2018 WORKSHOP**

ENGINEER – D. GILLILAND:

1. Demolition in progress. 401 Orient and 133 Watkins and 70 Morningside are complete. He will return to Watkins to clear the steps that were left and to Morningside to remove trees and brush. He still has the 2 on Middle and the porch on Airbrake to complete.
2. No news on the Welsh/Orient slide. The report and application was submitted to Allegheny County. They will submit the application to PEMA who will submit to FEMA.
3. Mr. Glenn and I inspected another possible slide developing on Morningside. We can't see what is going on below it due to heavy vegetation. We recommend getting some hot asphalt and patch over the slum area to keep water away from it. We have had the camera truck up and the lines are fine.

S. SHURGOT: do we need 100 ft. of hot patch or should we do just from the sewer to the telephone pole.

D. GILLILAND: you want to go the whole length.

S. SHURGOT: can you get a price on that for us.

4. Ice Plant Road was looked at. The water is coming from storm sewers at the top of the hill in East McKeesport. I propose that we do a CITF application next year. This project will involve East McKeesport, North Versailles, Brandywine, Allegheny County and the Borough of Wilmerding. I need to get everyone together to explain the problem and get a plan together.

J. THOMAS: the Herman Avenue project is that curb to curb and can we minimize the project?

D. GILLILAND: you have to talk to Bob. ALCOSAN is not approving application this round for the type pf project we did last year but they will for the next round and he feels we have a good chance at getting full funding.

P. SHURGOT: would you be able to do one half at a time so we can keep traffic flowing. Part of the project will be separating the storm sewer and taking that over to a separate storm sewer on Westinghouse, which would be the 1st phase.
